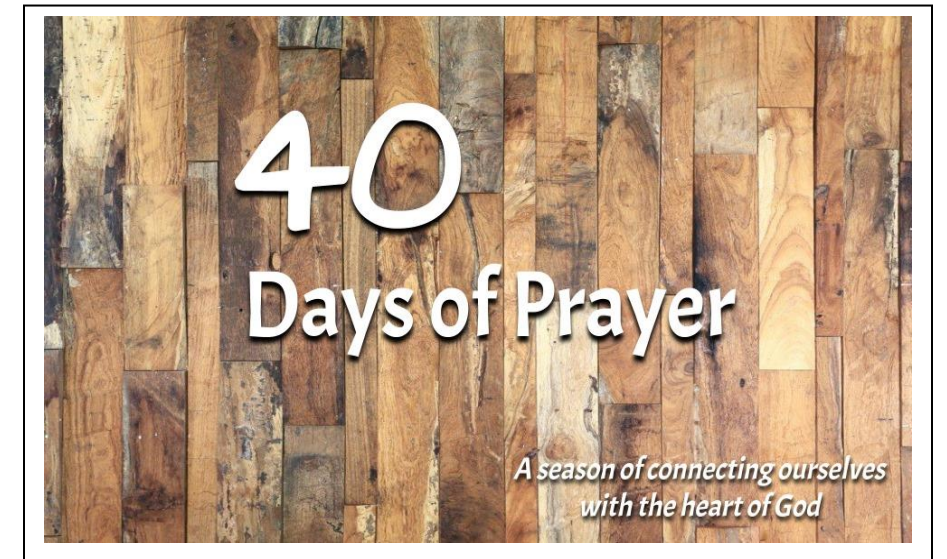

## From the Pastor

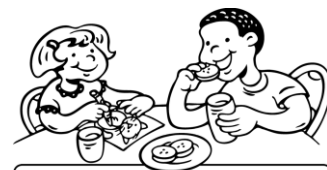
